SITE INFORMATION

The trial will be run outdoors. It is a ONE RING trial. The running surface will be sand if the weather is wet, or grass if dry weather prevails. There is ample water on site but shade is in short supply, so bring your canopy.

On-site camping is limited (see page 3). Information and links to local hotels and campgrounds can be found on our web page.

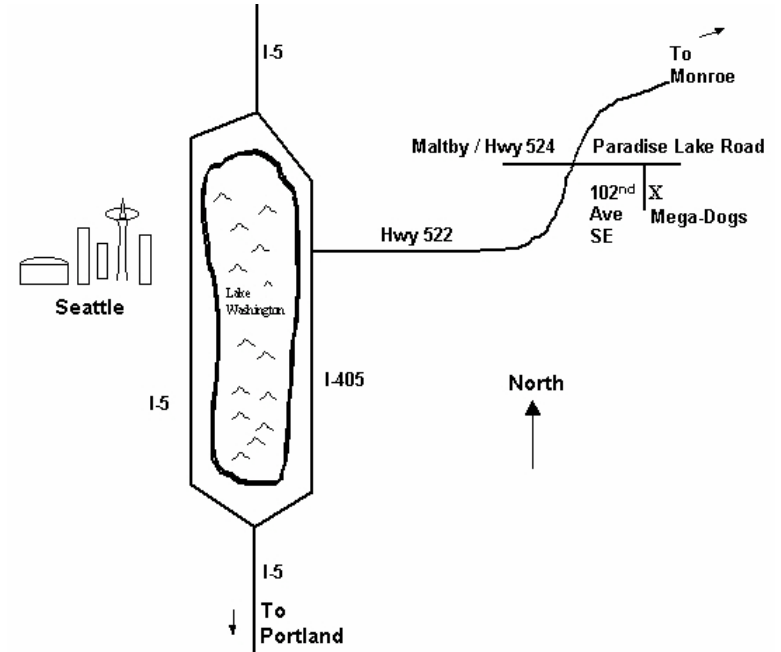

DIRECTIONS TO MEGA-DOGS 22609 102nd Ave SE Woodinville, WA 98077

From I-405 take Hwy 522 East (exit #23). Go about 4 miles to the first stop light and take a right onto Paradise Lake Road. Go 1 mile to 102nd Ave SE and turn right. It's the fourth driveway on the left.



We encourage you to come by on Friday to set up. You may drop off equipment in the circular drive, but please move quickly so the next person will have a chance to do the same. During the trial we will park as many people as possible on site (tent campers get priority) – watch for signs and/or a parking attendant. Please do not arrive before 6 a.m.

CAR PARKING

The trial site is in a residential area. Parking will be limited, so carpoolers will be much appreciated.

RV PARKING

We do not have room for motor homes or trailers on the trial site, but a couple of my neighbors have generously offered to allow RVs to park on their property. There will be very few of these spaces, and advance reservations are required. There is a \$15/night fee for this parking.

TENT CAMPING

Tent camping will be permitted, but please be aware that the camping area is right next to the crating/spectator area. The fee for tent camping is \$3/night, and showers will be available.

It's YOUR Trial!

Your help is needed to hold a successful trial. We are asking all entrants to help with *just one thing* each day (of course, we'll let you do more if you like).

We'll have a sign-up sheet at the trial where you can choose what you'd like to do and when. Come early to get your favorite jobs, but don't worry – there's plenty for everyone!

ENTRY RULES

There is no opening date, so you may enter immediately.

All entries postmarked on or before April 15th will be entered into a draw to be held on April 20th. There is no advantage to entering early, but also no penalty. We will not accept entries requiring a signature or electronic entries.

REFUNDS

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds will be given for bitches that come in heat after May 19th. Refunds minus a small fee (depending on the withdrawal date) will be given for injury or illness.

MOVE-UPS

After submitting your entry form, we will accept move-ups or changes ***in writing only*** (email is ok) until 5 p.m. on May 19th. No changes will be accepted after this date/time. There will be no move-ups during the trial.

MEASURING

All Novice, Open, and Elite dogs will be measured at check-in, except dogs competing in the 20 or 20+ jump height category, veteran dogs jumping 16", dogs entered in the skilled category, or dogs with a permanent height card.

AWARDS

First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes (except Chances, which is a pass/fail class) and levels. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for any qualifying run.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial is sanctioned by the North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC) with Mega-Dogs as the sponsor club. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

****Dog must be registered** and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

Through submission of their entry, the exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitors Handbook.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACagility@yahoogroups.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

Non-Jumping classes – Veteran Handler:

Disabled handlers or handlers aged 60 yrs. or older may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This division is for handlers only. The 10% additional SCT is for qualifying purposes only for those who may need the additional time to negotiation the course due to physical limitations. Veteran Handlers in the non-jumping classes will be scored and placed with their standard division jump height. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all classes and all dogs in this division for the weekend.

Agreement

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), Mega-Dogs Agility (including its officers, agents, and employees), and Steve and Karen Hunter, and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Exhibitor/owner hereby assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the afore-mentioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

I have read, understand, and acknowledge the above Agreement. I further acknowledge that I am knowledgeable of the North American Dog Agility Council's (NADAC) Rules and Regulations governing sanctioned agility trials

HEAD START FRIDAY EVENING

We MAY be offering a "head start" of Touch & Go on Friday evening. This is dependent on the judge being willing and available, the weather cooperating, and the trial organizers being ready.

In a head start run, you have the OPTION of doing your Touch & Go run on Friday evening instead of Saturday. The course is left untouched overnight, and then everyone else who didn't run the course on Friday will do it on Saturday morning.

SATURDAY POTLUCK !

Join us Saturday evening after the last run for a relaxed get-together. Mega-Dogs will provide a grill and grill master, plus plenty of yummy desserts and soft drinks.
